


Happy Easter!

As the Easter celebration rapidly approaches, let's review some of the glorious truths resurrection reveals about the Lord Jesus Christ!

He was sinless. 1 Corinthians 15:56 reveals that death's "sting" is contained in sin: "The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law." The fact death had no hold on Christ proves there was no sin in him for death to "take hold of."

He actually died. Contrary to Islam's teaching that Jesus Christ was replaced by a proxy on the cross, the Jewish Sanhedrin, Pontius Pilate, Joseph of Arimathea, disciples, Jesus's mother, and Roman centurions who accomplished the crucifixion were all satisfied it was Jesus of Nazareth





We are made alive in him! John 7:38 speaks of abundant life in Christ, "He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." And he told Lazarus' sister Martha, "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die" (John 11:25-6). In Christ, death becomes an irate bumblebee with no stinger (1 Corinthians 15:55) – comical, perhaps annoying, but no longer fearsome.

He loves us! Romans 5:8 says the crucifixion is proof of God's love: "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

The story doesn't end there! Revelation 22:20 says, "He which testifieth these things saith, 'Surely I come quickly.' Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus." Our sinless, crucified, risen, and ascended Lord is set to return soon! And so we echo the apostle John, "Even so, come, Lord Jesus!"
