HAPPY *ETERNAL* INDEPENDENCE DAY

Galatians 5:1; 13

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

This Independence Day we remember our civil liberties, granted to few in human history. The right to vote for officials, speak openly and demand redress of grievances, and most importantly worship according to the dictates of individual conscience are hallmarks of the great American experience. John Wesley addressed the religious freedoms we enjoy in a letter to Bishop Coke in September 1784: "As our American brethren are now totally disentangled, both from the state and the English hierarchy, we dare not entangle them again, either with the one or the other. They are now at full liberty simply to follow the Scriptures and the primitive church. And we judge it best that they should stand fast in that liberty wherewith God has so strangely made them free."

Just as we resent any encroachments to our civil or religious freedoms, Paul warned us long ago in the book of Galatians to carefully guard our spiritual freedom in Christ. Sadly many Christians today view freedom in Christ as freedom from following rules. I can watch and listen to what I want, speak how I want, spend my time how I want, dress how I want, treat others how I want. The most popular example of this perhaps, was Elvis Presley. A famous preacher questioned why he was living a lavish rock and roll lifestyle, after receiving Christ age 12 at a Mississippi revival, and beginning his career singing gospel music? Elvis casually replied, "I got tired of following all those rules."

But true freedom in Christ is found in obedience to God! Our sins are forgiven so that we can walk victoriously and serve one another in the power of Christ. When we go our own way in search of freedom, we ironically find bondage and heartache. Nowhere else will ever be as free as walking in obedience to God's perfect law of liberty! Christian freedom is not freedom from the rules, but freedom to serve God and one another in love.

Will we use our liberty in Christ for good this Independence Day?
