

My yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

When fall bathes the mountains in God's colorful glory, we often take drives and hikes to "soak it all in" before winter moves in. We were blessed with a couple days in West Virginia to see New River Gorge, just as colorful and awe inspiring as you can imagine, and Glade Creek Grist Mill, one of the most beloved scenes in photography. Since millennia ago, mankind has harnessed the power of water God placed in his creation. In the case of flour mills, flowing water turns a large wheel which is connected by gears to a grinding stone, which transforms raw grain into flour to feed humanity. It would be possible for people or animals to hitch themselves to the millstone and turn it, but the raw power of flowing water makes the process much more efficient and effective - from a human standpoint seemingly effortless.

In much the same way Christians who have a desire to serve God in evangelism, praise, and community engagement face a daily decision. Do they wake up, put their feet on the floor, and attempt to do God's work on their own power? It may be possible for a brief while, but mostly frustrating and exhausting. The other (much better!) choice is to "hitch" themselves to Christ through his Holy Spirit, and serve God in the power of God. In that way more is accomplished better, and we aren't left feeling run over by a truck at the end of each day. Christ stood up in a public forum and cried out,"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." Is there a yoke in praising God? Yes. Is there a burden in serving God? Yes. But if we are praising and serving God by the very power of God, it is described as "easy," and "light." The Holy Spirit lives within believers, so if we find ourselves tired or frustrated in God's work why not ask him to turn the wheel by his effortless power, rather than our very limited? Then this season, serving God wholeheartedly, we can truly "enter his gates with Thanksgiving, and his courts with praise!" Pastor Rob
