DESTROYING DEATH THROUGH DEATH

A common theme in TV, books and movies is, in order to defeat your enemy you must destroy the source of his power. This principle is lifted straight out of the pages of God's word, namely Hebrews 2:14-15, "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." In Rocky that means taking it on the chin for multiple rounds until your opponent punches himself out, exhausted. In Mission Impossible, the hero retrieves highly encrypted data from a secure computer terminal inside a Langley CIA vault. In Return of the Jedi Lando Calrissian flies down an impossibly narrow corridor to fire photon torpedoes at a power reactor, blowing up the Empire's death star from within.


As Jesus died on the cross and descended into hell he entered the devil's stronghold, only to bust hell and the grave wide open! Colossians 2:14-15, "Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it." In verse 14 the Lord Jesus Christ paid the ransom for our sin to God the Father, NOT the devil. What good would it be to pay a ransom for sin to Satan, who himself is under a greater eternal curse than any member of the human race? After Christ paid our debt to God on the cross and declared, "It is finished!," he entered hell itself and deposited all the sins of all humanity there in a sea of forgetfulness. And just when the powers of hell thought they had God's son locked up in the grave, he calmly took the keys of death and hell from them (Revelation 1:18), and ripped the gates of hell out of their walls and foundation, Matthew 16:18. A beautiful picture of this is given in Judges 16:1-3 as Samson's enemies "lock him up" within the city gates of Gaza, only for Samson to calmly rip the gates and posts out, carrying them far away.

The classic Easter hymn Christ Arose sets this awe inspiring scene to music in its third verse:

Death cannot keep his prey Jesus, my Savior! He tore the bars away Jesus my Lord!

May we ever remember if we have received Christ by faith, death has no more hold on us than it does on the blessed Captain of our salvation, the Lord Jesus Christ himself! He entered death and hell for the sole purpose of tearing the bars away!
